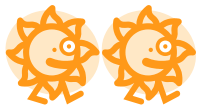

# Beat the Heat!

The temperatures will be climbing into the 90's. Many students find the adjustment to the heat very difficult at first. Students should begin to prepare for the heat **NOW**-

**Exercise.** Marching Band is one of the most strenuous activities in high school, especially in the heat of summer. Rehearsals take place in the front parking lot. We will be rehearsing in the evenings during August to allow for some relief in temperature. Students need to spend some time *outside each day!* **Don't come to camp...out of shape!**

**Hydrate.** Beginning one week before camp, increase your water consumption. Pre-hydration is **CRUCIAL** to surviving the heat. Drinking fluids the day of camp is important, but that will only replace fluids. Students should drink a minimum of 6-8 glasses of water each day.

**No Caffeine.** Caffeine is dangerous in the heat. Bring a personal water cooler to rehearsal. Eat a well-balanced breakfast before camp each day. Refrain from caffeine products two days prior to camp!

**Wear a Hat.** Wearing a hat protects your face and head from the sun.

**Dress Cool.** Wear light colored clothing and shorts [no drop jaw!] Wear cotton and avoid polyester and synthetic fabrics, which retain body heat. Guard will wear black shorts, black tank top (no spaghetti straps) and black split sole jazz shoes.

**Sunscreen.** Wear at least a 15 SPF no matter who you are or how tan you think you are. SPF 30 or higher is recommended due to the amount of time you will spend in rehearsal outside. Reapply frequently.

**MB Music Preparation.** The music will be the primary focus of week one of camp. Students should arrive being able to play all three movements. It is not required that it be memorized. The Section Showdown will be the first opportunity for you to perform the 1<sup>st</sup> movement by memory for your peers.

**Camp Meal Times.** There will be meal breaks, which will allow students the opportunity to leave campus or bring a lunch/dinner to eat at school. **MANY DO!** Parent volunteers will be on duty during rehearsals and breaks. Parents are responsible for their student. Students riding in another student's vehicle should have permission from their parents.

**There will be a parent meeting for all students in band class or color guard, Monday, July 19<sup>th</sup>,** following the Pot Luck Dinner which begins at 6:30 p.m. in the Dining Hall. Please mark your calendar. A minimum of one parent per family is required to attend.

## Vehicle Donation Program!

Did you know that you can donate your vehicle to the HHBB Vehicle Donation Program and the IRS allows you, the taxpayer, to claim a tax deduction of (a) the value of your vehicle up to \$500 or (b) if the vehicle sells for more than \$500, actual selling price? This fundraiser benefits The HHS Marching Band – Winter Guard, which will receive 70% of the selling price of the vehicle. All you need to do is submit a Vehicle Donation Request Form; Car Program LLC will do the rest. They will arrange for the vehicle to be picked up or towed, if necessary, and will assume all responsibility for the selling of the vehicle; as well as providing the donor with the forms for tax deductibility.
