Note to Wind Ensemble: Please wait to have your concert attire dry cleaned after your last concert.

**Please return your concert attire in the dry cleaners bag with the receipt attached.**

Your student was given two numbered hangers that correspond to the numbers inside the jacket and trousers and/or top and skirt, along with a garment bag at the time of issue. Please make sure that the hangers and garment bag are returned, along with the professionally cleaned tuxedo and/or top and skirt.

The shirt, cummerbund, studs and cuff links are not rented and belong to your student. The same goes for the pearls purchased by the girls.
